## New FREE online guides for parents

Warwickshire Public Health have some online courses that you as a parent can access to build up your confidence. The three guides below are designed to support mums, dads and carers in developing positive relationships with their infants and children. In turn, this will help to strengthen emotional resilience and wellbeing, so infants and children are able to bounce back from life's various challenges

- . understanding your child (for parents of 0 - 18yr olds)
- . understanding your baby ( newborn)
- . understanding your pregnancy

By the time children reach 14yrs of age, 50% of mental health problems are already established, so we know we need to act in Warwickshire to help grow parents confidence, understanding and responsiveness to their children.

If you would like to confirm your booked sessions, invoice details and payments, these may be accessed through a secure parent's portal. In order to access this please ask Rick or myself.














We introduced our parents to the fun finger gym activities that the children can access.
