Dear Parents and Carers,

New starters

Invoices

Invoices are emailed out at the beginning of each term whether you pay or are funded. For those that pay it is important that fees are paid on time as per your fees contract.

Parking

Please ensure you are appropriately parked when dropping your child off at nursery and please refrain from parking on the double yellow lines.

Having a chat

We may at times have to have a chat with parents at the end of a session and this can be difficult if your child is running off

around the car park or pathway. We must remember we are on a school site and therefore the car park belongs to them. Please do not allow your child to run towards the school windows or entrance as it is disturbing to them. Thank you for your co-operation.

This is a bank holiday and schools and nurseries will be closed. We will be open as usual on Tuesday 3rd May.

School reception place

You should have all had your child's school place confirmed and you should have accepted it too. For anyone who has not heard, please let me know so I can help you. I will shortly have the reception teachers contacting me to find out a little more about your child.

I have sent home the funding forms to be signed and dated for the summer term. Please only fill in where highlighted and return to me as soon as possible. For all new children accessing funding for the first time, you will have more to fill in but I will guide you through this.

Sun cream

Although it doesn't seem it at the moment, the weather is likely to get warmer. Therefore, we ask that you apply sun cream to your child prior to them entering nursery. If your child is allergic to certain sun creams, then can you provide their own labelled one with their name on it. We will have some sun cream which we can use for topping up children which will be a shop own brand.

Clothes

Can you please return any clothes that you have borrowed from nursery so that we can keep our stock levels high? If anyone has any joggers for an older child age 5-8yrs, could we have some please. They are good to have as spares for our older children.

Holiday Club

We try and run a holiday club during the summer break depending on demand. I will be sending out a booking form in a couple of weeks' time for you to book some sessions if you wish. All details of what will be available and costs will be explained on the booking form.

Funded children returning in September

For any parent wishing to apply for 30 funded hours in September you must apply now and get the 11-digit code to me as soon as you receive it. Here is the website for you to apply through:
