Christina Forrester is to work closely with Rick, as she will be taking on a key person's role in September.




Parking

Tuesday - crafts & gifts with Vera, cooking with Jess


Wednesday - arts & crafts with Claire or Jane

This month's recipe

This recipe was used in one of our cooking sessions and so we thought we would share it with you for you to try!

Cheese and cherry tomato muffins

Ingredients

225g/8oz self-raising flour $100g/3\frac{1}{2}$ oz courgette, grated Salt and freshly ground black pepper $100g/3\frac{1}{2}$ oz mature cheddar, grated 175ml/6fl oz milk

1 free-range egg

55ml/2fl oz olive oil

10 cherry tomatoes

Method

Preheat the oven to 200C/400F/Gas 6.

In a mixing bowl, combine the flour, courgette, salt, freshly ground black pepper and cheddar and mix well.

In a separate bowl, mix together the milk, egg and olive oil. Add this mixture to the dry ingredients and mix well.

Grease ten muffin moulds and half-fill each with the mix.

Prick each cherry tomato - this stops them popping when they cook - and press one tomato into the top of each spoonful of mix.

Spoon the remaining mixture over each muffin to conceal the tomato. Cook for about 20 minutes until golden brown.
